

### Welcome to Borlänge's compulsory schools

There is a reception class (kindergarten) at 15 schools in Borlänge Municipality. Our schools work for every child to feel safe and secure in school and to be offered the opportunity to learn from his or her level and feel a desire to learn new things. For us, it is important that the school and the home cooperate and together develop the children into good members of society.

#### School choice

In autumn 2024, it will be time for children born in 2018 to begin in a reception class. The reception class is compulsory for all children and school attendance is compulsory.

According to the Education Act, all guardians have a possibility to freely choose their child's school. We try to fulfil the choices you make as a guardian, but the capacity of the schools means that we cannot always take in everyone who wants to go to a certain school. In those cases, we use selection criteria. If you as a guardian do not make a choice of school for your child, we will place the child at a school close to home.

### School transport and choice of school

The right to school transport/a bus card is primarily examined to the school the municipality has assigned. If the pupil is entitled to school transport to the assigned school, school transport can in some cases also be granted to another chosen school within the municipality. More information on how to apply and relevant rules can be found on the website.

### **Independent schools**

In Borlänge, there is one independent school that has a reception class, Immanuelskolan. Guardians who choose an independent school as their first choice for their child must contact them directly and follow their application process. Important: You must still make a digital school choice

in the municipality's system and indicate that you applied to an independent school as your first choice.

**Tjärnaskolan** is an R-6 school with around 360 pupils. At the school, there are three before- and after-school recreation centre units that are divided by age, R-1, 2-3 and 4-6.

**Torsångs skola** is an R-3 school with around 115 pupils. The before- and after-school recreation centre has around 110 children and is divided into two mixed-age units.

**Amsbergs skola** is an R-3 school with around 50 pupils. The school has one before- and after-school recreation centre unit.

**Domnarvets skola** is an R-9 school with around 700 pupils, of which around 450 are in R-6. At the school, there are four before- and afterschool recreation centre units divided by age.

**Kvarnsvedens skola** is an R-6 school with around 490 pupils. The school has five before- and after-school recreation centre units.

## School choice period

The school choice is to be made digitally during the period of the  $11^{\text{st}}-27^{\text{th}}$  of December 2023. You need to have a Bank ID. If you do not have a Bank ID, you can get help from the <u>Service Centre</u> at Röda vägen 50 to submit an application. In your application, you can notify if you applied for a place at an independent school.
